BERGMANSON: ROUSSEAU'S "NO" AND CORZINE'S "NO ANSWER" ILLUSTRATE THE PROBLEM

Glen Ridge, NJ – Mayor Carl Bergmanson, Jon Corzine's opponent for Governor in the upcoming Democratic Primary, says that recent statements by Governor Corzine and State Treasurer David Rousseau demonstrate just how "out-of-touch" with the taxpayer the Corzine Administration is.

Bergmanson, the former Mayor of Glen Ridge, said "On Tuesday, when Assemblyman Joe Malone asked Jon Corzine's State Treasurer David Rousseau if he thought New Jerseyans were overtaxed and Rousseau answered "No", the hard truth was revealed.
